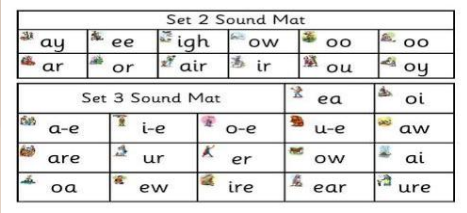
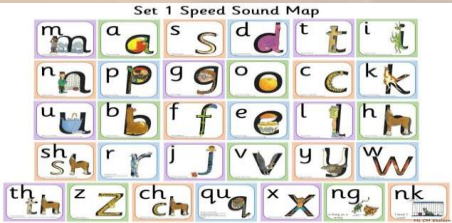


RWI:

English: This term in English, we will be using Traction Man as our stimulus for writing. Our writing opportunities will be

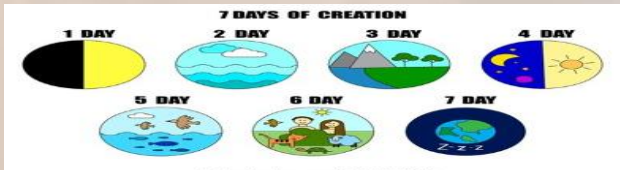
- Character description

Religion: Creation and Covenant

This term we will focus on:

Science: Everyday Materials

This term we will explore everyday materials and learn about them in the following ways:

- distinguishing between an object and the material from which it is made
- identifying and naming a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock
- describing the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials
- comparing and grouping together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties

Art: Drawing and Collage

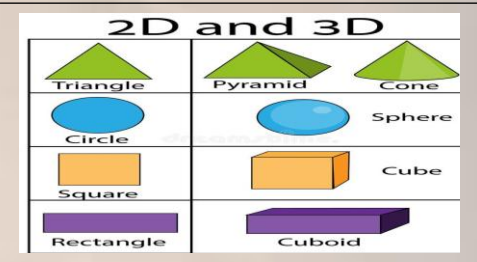
Artist: Jean Michel Basquiat

Maths: Shape and Number and Place Value to 10

- Representing numbers - Ordering and comparing objects and numbers

PE: Fundamentals
